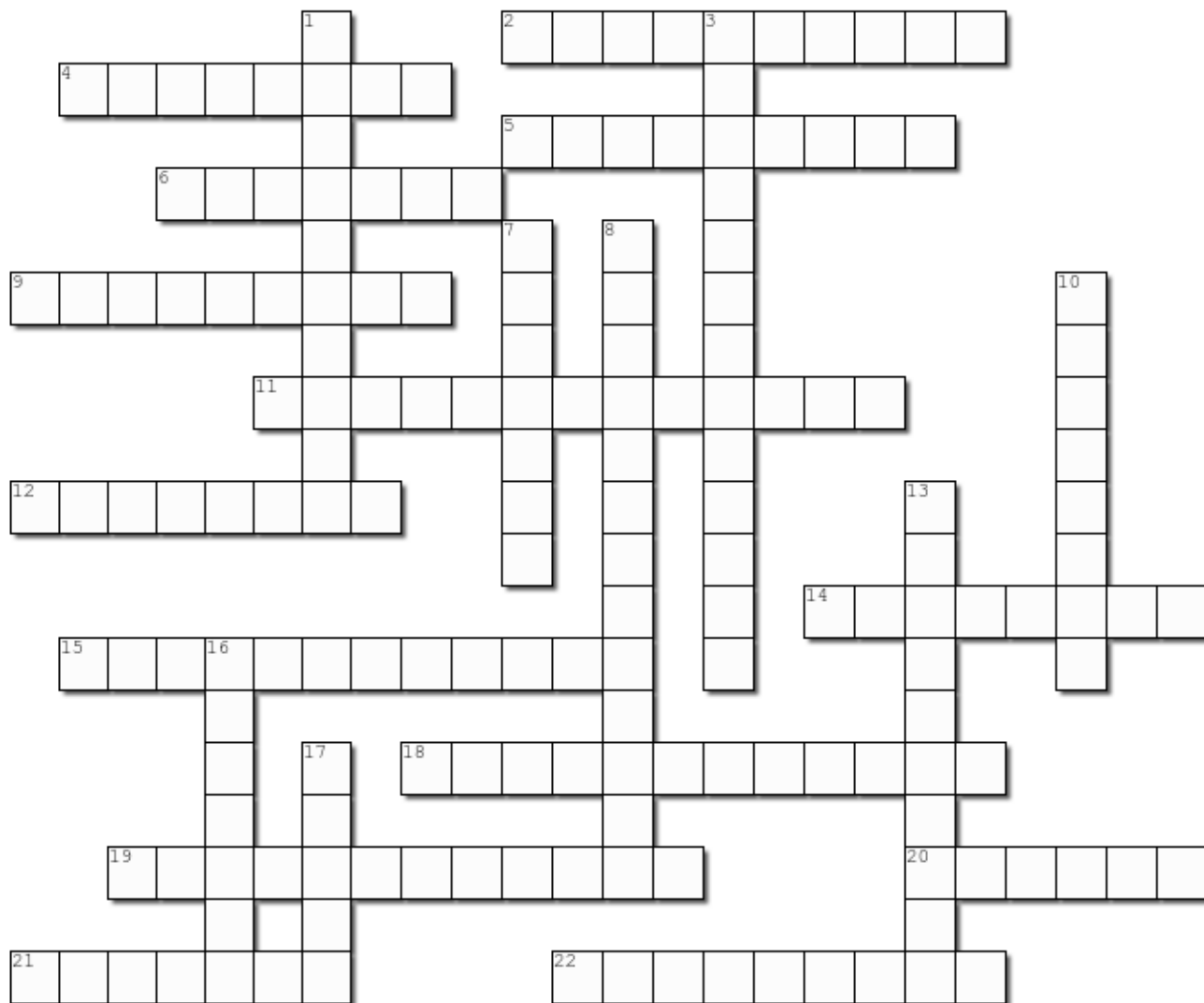


Crossword
