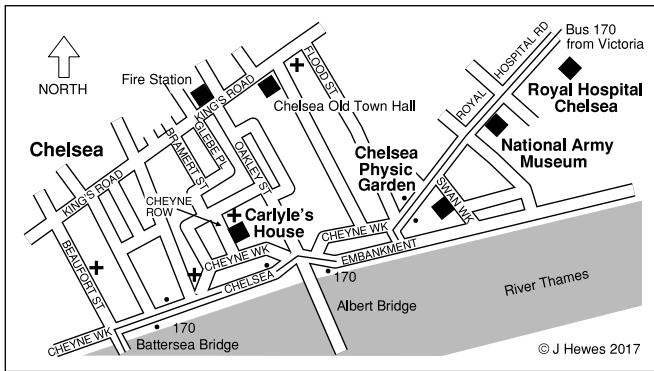
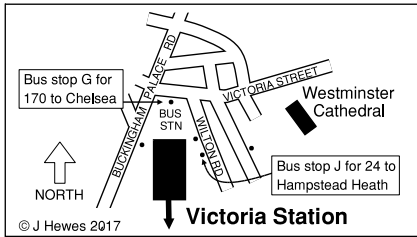


Carlyle's House

Open: Mar-Oct, WThFSSu & BH 1100-1700.

Bus 170 from **Victoria** stop G to the Albert Bridge, then about 5 minutes walk.

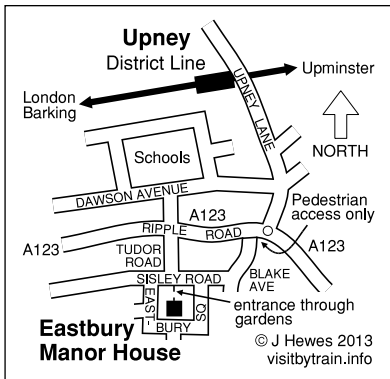


Eastbury Manor House

An Elizabethan brick-built house in tranquil gardens. Tearoom. Tel. 020 8227 2942.

Open: Apr-Nov, ThF 1000-1600, Sun 1200-1600, also mid Feb-Mar, ThF 1000-1600.

Underground District line to **Upney**, then about 10 minutes walk.



Fenton House

A 17th century merchant's house and walled garden. Collection of early keyboard instruments. Tel. 020 7435 3471.

Open: Mar-Oct, WThFSSu & BH 1100-1700.

2 Willow Road

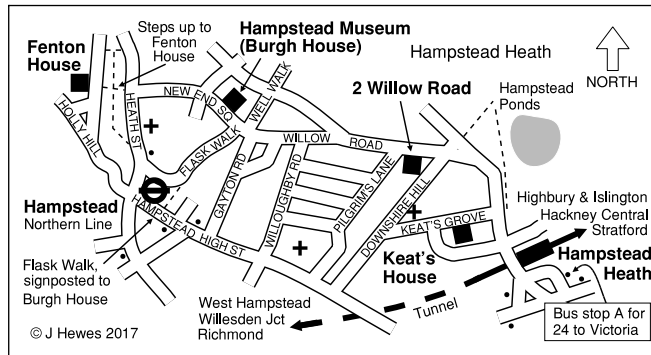
1930s Modernist home of architect Ernö Goldfinger, designed and furnished by him. 20th century art. Tel. 020 7435 6166.

Open: Mar-Oct, WThFSSu 1100-1700. Guided tours at 1100, 1200, 1300, 1400 (telephone to confirm WThF tours). Self-guided from 1500.

Overground to **Hampstead Heath** then 10 minutes walk to 2 Willow Road, or 25 minutes uphill walk to Fenton House.

Underground Northern line to **Hampstead** (Edgware branch, change at Camden Town if necessary). Fenton House is about 10 minutes walk uphill, 2 Willow Road is 15 minutes walk.

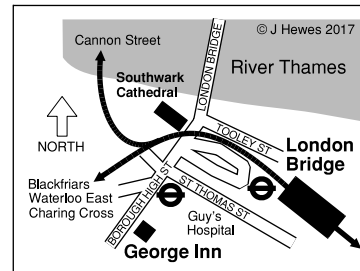
Bus 24 from Victoria (stop J) and near Charing Cross (Trafalgar Square stop C) to Hampstead Heath station (the route terminus), then 10 minutes walk to 2 Willow Road, or 25 minutes uphill to Fenton House.



George Inn

The last remaining galleried inn in London. Open: Licensing hours. Tel. 020 7407 2056.

Train or Underground to **Ridlon Bridge** then 5 minutes walk (less from the Underground's Borough High St exit).

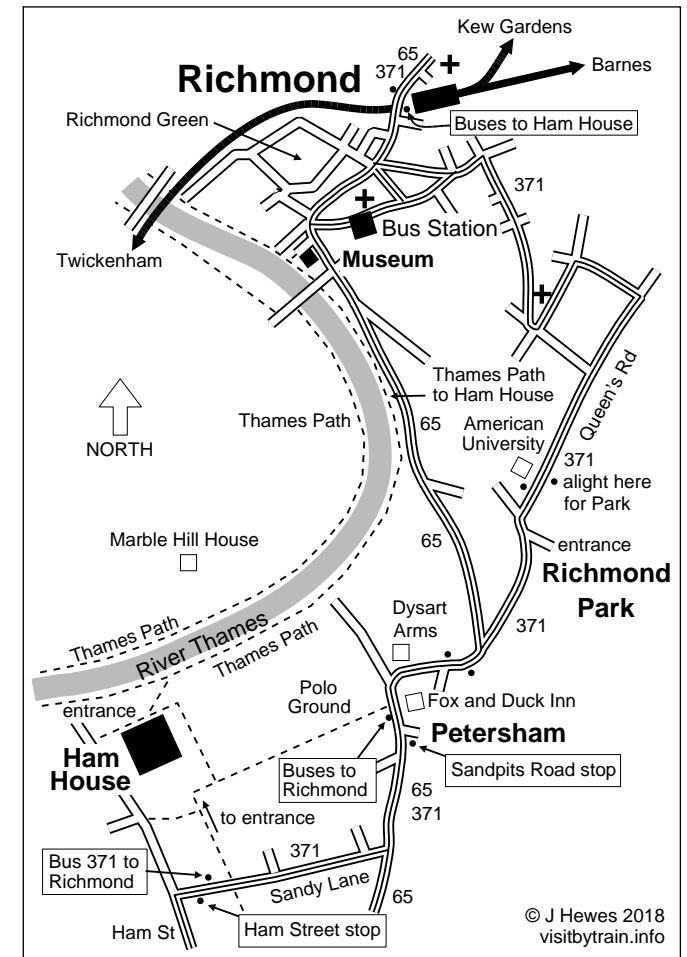


Ham House and Garden

A 17th century house at the heart of Restoration court life. Original interiors. Gardens. Dairy. Orangery café. Tel. 020 8940 1950.

Open: Daily 1200-1600, Garden from 1000. Note that only selected rooms are open in winter.

Train from Waterloo and Clapham Junction or **Underground** District line to **Richmond** then bus 65 to Petersham, 'Sandpits Road' stop and 20 minutes walk (¾ mile) or bus 371 to 'Ham Street' stop and 15 minutes walk (½ mile). *You may prefer to walk 1¾ miles from Richmond via the Thames Path, allow 45 minutes.*



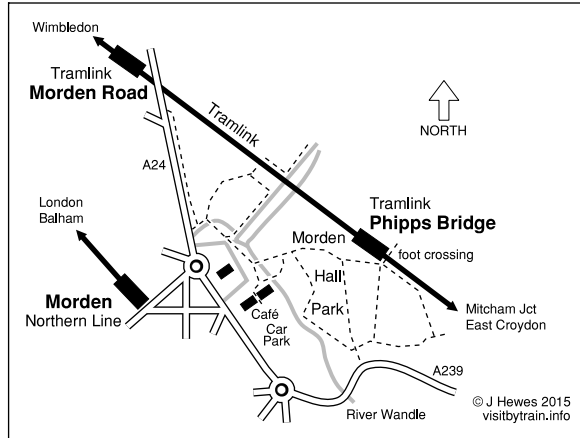

Morden Hall Park

Park crossed by River Wandle, rose garden, craft workshops, garden centre, café. Tel. 020 8545 6850. Open: Daily 0800-1700, Café 0900-1800.

Tram (Wimbledon line) to **Phipps Bridge**.

Underground Northern line to **Morden**, 5 min. walk.



Red House

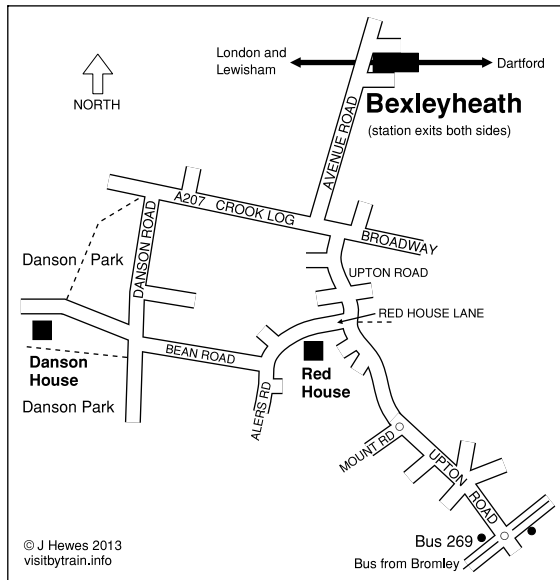
The home of William Morris, designed by Philip Webb. Garden. Tearoom. Tel. 020 8304 9878.

Open: Mar-Oct WThFSSu & BH 1100-1700.

Guided tours in morning, self-guided from 1330.

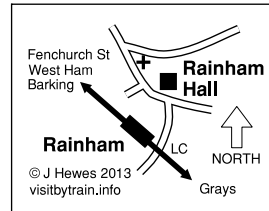
Bus 269 from Bromley North to Bexleyheath, Upton Road, then 20 minutes walk (¾ mile).

Train to **Bexleyheath** then 20 minutes walk.



Rainham Hall

An early 18th century merchant's house, exhibitions about residents. Garden. Café. Tel. 01708 525579. Open: WThFSSu & BH 1000-1700, subject to change. **Train** every 30 minutes from Fenchurch Street and West Ham (interchange for Jubilee and District lines) to **Rainham** then 5 minutes walk.



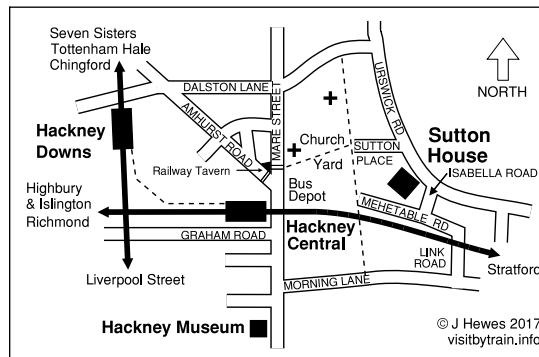
Sutton House and Breaker's Yard

A Tudor house with a fascinating history. Oak-panelled rooms, carved fireplaces. Art Gallery. Tearoom.

Tel. 020 8986 2264.

Open: 6-21 Apr, 10 Jul - 22 Sep, 19-27 Oct, 23 Nov - 22 Dec, WThFSSu & BH 1200-1630.

Overground to **Hackney Central**, 10 minutes walk through churchyard into Sutton Place and turn right.

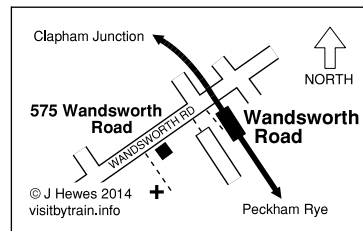


575 Wandsworth Road

A terraced house with amazing hand-carved fretwork.

Open: Mar-Oct, pre-booked tours, tel. 0344 249 1895.

Overground to **Wandsworth Road**, 5 minutes walk.



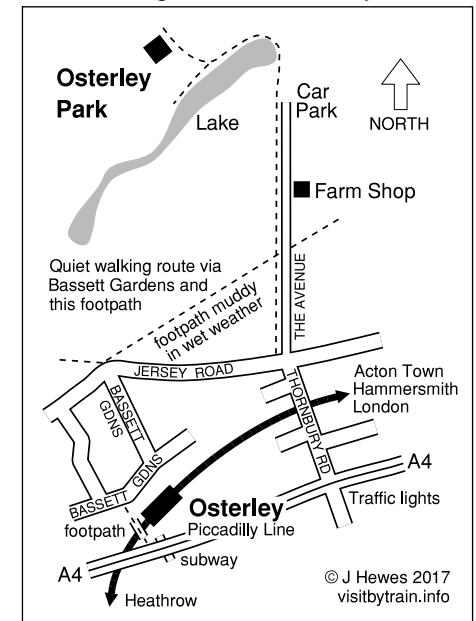
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Osterley Park and House

A neo classical house with Adam interiors. Basement exhibition. Garden. Woodland trail. Park. Café. Tel. 020 8232 5050.

Open: Daily 1000-1700, House 1100-1600 guided tours for first hour. Only selected rooms are open in winter.

Underground Piccadilly line to Osterley (on Heathrow branch) then about 20 minutes walk via the footpath shown on the map. From the District line take an Ealing Broadway or Richmond train to Hammersmith for easy cross-platform change to the Piccadilly line.
